3. Manuscript Submission:

- (9) **References:** Cite references by "last name, year", e.g. "(Smith, 2003)". References should include all the authors' last names and initials, title, journal, year, volume, issue, and pages etc. Reference Examples:

- (10) **Reviewers:** Authors are encouraged to suggest 2 competent reviewers one from Universities and the other from Research Center or Institutions.
